Marquee Sports Network talent will cover all three games, as TV announcers Len Kasper and Jim Deshaies will be on the call from the Wrigley Field booth for all the exhibition games; reporter Taylor McGregor will handle in-game duties from inside Wrigley Field for the Cubs' two home games and inside Guaranteed Rate Field when the team plays at the White Sox. Health and safety protocols will be followed by everyone involved in the broadcast.

All regular season Cubs games this season will be on Marquee Sports Network, unless selected as a national exclusive telecast.
